

Several branches of the NRC have already cooperated with the Director of the National Museum of Science and Technology and I have had correspondence with him in regard to continued cooperation and arrangements for the occasional transfer of equipment or artifactual material for display in the National Museum.

In order to get an NRC policy outlined, a small committee consisting of J.T. Henderson, M.S. Kuhring and D.C. Rose has been appointed to recommend a general policy and procedure. The problem is complicated by the existence of an Associate Committee on National Museums of Science and Technology which replaced an earlier Associate Committee on a National Aviation Museum. This committee has under its control an appreciable collection of aviation material and a trust fund.

The small Committee of three mentioned above has produced the attached report making certain recommendations and these have the approval of the Administrative Committee. I would be grateful for your comments and for the name of the officer representing your Division in accordance with paragraph 1 on page 4 of these recommendations.

The officer whose function is described in paragraph 3 on page 4 of this report will be appointed later.
