
Pursuant to Order-in-Council

Dr. David Keys will continue as Vice-President (Scientific) in charge of the Atomic Energy Project. Dr. E. W. R. Steacie has been appointed to the new position as Vice-President (Scientific) for National Research Council, Ottawa.

Dr. Steacie will retain his position as Director of the Division of Chemistry and will continue his own research in the field of chemical kinetics and photochemistry.

In his new office Dr. Steacie will assume direct responsibility in connection with fellowships, grants in aid, general scientific staff matters and extra mural activities of a scientific nature.

The new Vice-President will keep in general touch with the many activities of the Council so that his advice on general scientific policy matters may be available. He will deputize for the President on scientific and technical matters when necessary and, while he will be available for consultation, he will not assume any administrative responsibility in connection with Divisional affairs as such. The Directors of National Research Laboratories will report direct to and be responsible to the President's office as at present.
